**Item 4 SIDs and Police Report**

AP reminded everyone that Speedwatch is to be suspended during winter months. New SIDs are the way forward. He stated that motorists take notice of speedguns and subsequent fines. Speedguns are to be deployed and extra officers at Newport Pagnell have been trained in their use. There are ongoing investigations relating to a number of crimes within the area.

DC spoke about Training Course (Health and Safety) in the use of SIDs. Visible presence at Speedwatch by NAG members, volunteers and PCSOs is still appreciated by locals. Perhaps new rota could be drawn up as better weather approaches. Until Haversham come on board Hanslope to retain one SID and Castlethorpe to have the other.

PA suggested we ask Adrian Carden for spare brackets for SIDs.

TM, SM mentioned the need for a pole at Hartwell end of Hartwell Road, Hanslope.
